ANIMAL ORDINANCE

MOSCOW BOROUGH ORDINANCE #195-2007, PERTAINS IN PART TO SPECIFYING TIME LIMITS AND LIMITED HOURS FOR DOGS BARKING. ALL DOGS MUST BE LEASHED AT ALL TIMES; AND IF ANY ANIMAL (DOG OR CAT) DEFECATES IN ANY AREA OTHER THAN THE PRIVATE PROPERTY OF THE OWNER, THE PET OWNER IS REQUIRED TO IMMEDIATELY REMOVE AND DISPOSE OF THE FECES PROPERLY. THE BOROUGH OFFICE HAS RECEIVED COMPLAINTS ABOUT INDIVIDUALS ALLOWING THEIR PETS (DOGS AND CATS) TO STRAY OFF OF

ALLOWING THEIR PETS (DOGS AND CATS) TO STRAY OFF OF THEIR PROPERTY AND COMPLAINTS ABOUT INDIVIDUALS NOT CLEANING UP AFTER THEIR PETS WHEN WALKING THEM ALONG BOROUGH STREETS.
