FRIENDLY REMINDERS

ORDINANCES AND PERMIT COMPLIANCE

The Borough of Moscow enforces property codes and local ordinances to maintain community standards and ensure resident safety. These rules regulate land use, building maintenance, and property appearance.

Common code violations include :

- High Grass / Weeds/ Property Maintenance
- Vehicle Violations
- Waste & Debris
- Building Construction (No permit)
- Housing Issues (Roofs, Windows, etc)
- Pet Noise

REAL ESTATE TAXES

- The penalty period for payment of Real Estate Taxes is from July 1, 2026 through December 31, 2026
- Past due notices will be issued October 2026
- Taxes become Delinquent if they are not paid by December 31, 2026
- All delinquent taxes will be turned over to Lackawanna County for collection
